- 13. Encourage all divers to obey the spirit of the rules and regulations both in and out of the pool.
- 14. Never encourage or condone members, volunteers, officials or parents to violate the rules of the organisation or the sport, and report any violations appropriately.
- 15. Observe the authority and the decision of the officials and only question those decisions in the appropriate manner.
