Plymouth Diving Code of Conduct - Parents and Carers

The purpose of this form is to keep a record of Parents and Carers agreeing to the Plymouth Diving Code of Conduct.

 I will complete and return the Membership Form as requested by the Membership Secretary and provide details of any health conditions/concerns relevant to my child on the form. I will report any changes in the state of my child's health to the coach prior to training sessions/events. I will ensure that the club has up to date contact details.
I will ensure my child arrives punctually for training sessions/events and inform their coach or a member of the coaching team if there is an unavoidable problem. I will inform the coach before a session if my child is going to be absent or is to be excused early from a training session/event.

- 3. I will ensure my child is properly and adequately attired for training sessions/events.
- 4. I will not enter poolside unless requested to do so or in an emergency.
- 5. I will leave the coaching to the coach and not interfere.

6. I will behave responsibly as a spectator during training sessions/events and treat coaches, committee members, parents from any club and divers with due respect, in accordance with the Swim England commitment to equality. I will show appreciation and support my child and all team members.

7. I will inspire my child to enjoy diving and do their best – I will not have unrealistic expectations of their performance or exhibit signs of disappointment or negativity.

8. I will not use inappropriate language within the club environment.

9. I will encourage my child to obey the rules.

10. I will support the coach and committee fittingly and raise any concerns I may have in an appropriate manner to the Welfare Officer.

The Club will:

1. Inform you at once if your child becomes ill and will ensure their wellbeing until you are able to collect them.

2. Ensure good child safeguarding guidelines are followed at all times to keep your child safe.

3. Ensure all activities are properly supervised/taught/coached.

You have a right to:

1. Make a complaint to the club if you feel the club or a member of the club is not acting appropriately or in accordance with Swim England/club rules and regulations. Details of

how to do this can be obtained from the Welfare Officer.

2. Make a complaint on behalf of your child to the Swim England Office of Judicial Administration.
